1. Trip	Overview	
	Trip Dates: Confirm the start and end dates of your trip.

Roadside Assistance: Have a plan for roadside assistance (car insurance coverage, □ emergency numbers).  Documentation: Carry important documents like vehicle registration, insurance, and breakdown coverage.	
8. Packing for Special Activities		
	<b>Outdoor/Adventure Gear</b> : For hiking, biking, fishing, or water sports, ensure you have the right gear.	
	<b>Camera Gear</b> : Pack your camera, lenses, batteries, and memory cards if taking photos. <b>Books, Games, or Entertainment</b> : Bring along entertainment for long drives or downtime.	
9. Communication & Connectivity		
	<b>SIM Card/Internet:</b> Arrange for international SIM cards or data plans (if needed). <b>Wi-Fi:</b> Know where you'll have access to Wi-Fi for work, communication, or navigation. <b>Local Emergency Numbers:</b> Familiarise yourself with emergency numbers in the region.	
	<b>Travel Apps:</b> Download essential travel apps (currency converters, translation, maps, etc.).

	fore You Leave Final Walkthrough: Check that all systems (car, caravan, home) are ready for the trip. Travel Reminder: Set a reminder to leave at least 15 minutes earlier than planned. Documents & Keys: Ensure you have all essential documents and keys with you. Contact Family/Friends: Let family or friends know your travel details and itinerary for safety.
